

EURAAP *Travel Grants* **for UKRAINIAN researchers**

In the frame of the initiative “Solidarity with Ukraine”, which was first launched for EuCAP2023, the EurAAP Board of Directors has decided to continue supporting researchers with Ukrainian affiliation for EuCAP 2026 as follows:

1. Free registration to any Ukrainian affiliated person, who has an accepted paper and is also the presenting author.
2. Support up to 2 students with proven affiliation to a Ukrainian institution. The students should be authors of an accepted paper and the presenting author at EuCAP2026. Each grant consists of 750€ to support the travel expenses.

Application requirements

The application must include (in one single pdf file):

- Full name
- Email address
- If student, status should be specified (B.Sc, M.Sc, or Ph.D. as well as start and planned end dates), as well as the name of supervisor
- Proof of affiliation to a Ukrainian institution
- EuCAP 2026 accepted paper ID from EDAS and title
- Short motivation for the application (max. 250 words)

In addition, all students are encouraged to apply for other travel grants available for EuCAP 2026.

Application deadline

Students from Ukrainian institutions who have authored a paper at EuCAP 2026 and are presenting the corresponding accepted paper, are encouraged to send an application to travelgrants@eucap2026.org with "EurAAP Ukrainian Travel Grant" in the subject line before 25 January 2026.

The recipients of the travel allowance will be notified by 26 February 2026.

The selection criteria will be based on:

- **Paper Scoring:** Priority will be given to papers with high scores, evaluated on originality, significance, and clarity.
- **Motivation Letter:** Applicants must submit a letter explaining their reasons for attending, the benefit to their professional development, and the need for financial support.

Note: Applicants affiliated with Ukrainian institutions may contact the Travel Grant Chairs at any time before the Early Bird registration deadline to request a free registration fee code. Please remember to include proof of affiliation with a Ukrainian institution in your email.
